Joe Berkeley Lewis came from a very religious Baptist family and all of his upbringing and ideals were modeled from his early childhood. Sunday was the day for attending church and nothing else. The family attended for three generations. Sunday school, afternoon services, dinner and movies were all provided at the Church. Joe's school days started in Memphis, TN., and it took him two (2) full years before he could understand why he could not attend the school across the street from his home. That's when he realized he was a victim of a segregated school system.

When he was ten years old, father found employment in St. Louis and the family moved here. Joe attended several elementary schools and graduated from Simmons Elementary School. He then went to Beaumont High School as one of the first integrated classes in the City of St. Louis school system. After graduating from Beaumont High School, he entered Harris Teachers College as a Junior College student. He attended Harris for one year and transferred to Southern Illinois University on the East St. Louis campus. After several different jobs his father convinced him to go to engineering schools and after completing this course and receiving a certificate as a plant engineer, he began his new career.

Joe received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Management and a master's degree in Environment Health and Safety and is a Certified Plant Engineer (CPE). Joe is a life member of the Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity and belongs to the St. Louis Alumni Chapter.

Joe joined the Eugene G. Lacey Lodge #12 on November 11, 1969 and has held numerous offices in this Lodge including Worshipful Master. Joe joined the Holy Royal Arch Masons in far West Chapter #2 and has served as District Deputy Grand High Priest. He also has served as Eminent Commander of Onward Commander #2, Knights Templar and Right Eminent Grand Commander, Knights Templar of Missouri and its Jurisdiction. Joe is also a member of Eureka Consistory #29, AASR, Southern Jurisdiction and advanced to the 33 Grand Inspector General in 1985. Joe was created a Noble in Medinah Temple #39 in July 1971 and elected Illustrious Potentate in December 1984. He has held numerous appointments in the Imperial Council, A.E.A.O.N.M.S. including the Imperial Deputy of the Desert of Missouri, Thrice Illustrious Master 2013 - Graham #2, Past General Grand Council High Priest, Past Most Eminent Grand Master Knight Templar.
