## **Biography of Most Eminent Past Grand Master Samuel Davis**

Samuel Davis, a native of Florence, South Carolina, was born on July 14, 1951, in Darlington, South Carolina. Growing up in this close-knit town, he was profoundly influenced by local figures, especially his grandfather, whose wisdom and guidance instilled in him values of leadership, service, and integrity.

After graduating from Mayo High School, Davis served honorably in the United States Marine Corps. Following his military service, he began his Masonic journey in 1972 at Morning Light Lodge No. 430 under the jurisdiction of South Carolina. He advanced through the ranks of Freemasonry, becoming a member of the Capitular, Cryptic, and Chivalric bodies. His affiliations with local Masonic houses include:

In 1976, Davis became a Shriner in Crescent Temple No. 148, part of the Ancient Egyptian Arabic Order Nobles Mystic Shrine of North and South America and Its Jurisdictions, Inc. He served as Potentate and was later honored with the title of Honorary Past Imperial Potentate, bestowed by Illustrious Imperial Potentate Karl Parker.

Within his Grand body, Davis serves as the Lecturer and has been a Past District and Special Deputy of the 9th district, focusing on Masonic education for his jurisdiction, the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge, Free and Accepted Masons, Jurisdiction of South Carolina. At the state level, he has held prominent roles, including:
